Planned PETHood of GA gives every pet in our care the time and support they need to find a loving home. However, because we take in some very vulnerable and sick pets—including newborn orphaned kittens—some of the pets in our care do pass away or are humanely euthanized to end suffering due to incurable disease.

**Planned PETHood of GA works with the local community to Trap, Neuter and Return feral/community cats. Every cat we fix as part of this program is technically "owned" by a person or business and we are permitted to Trap, Neuter and Return the animals on their property. For this reason, these animals are not counted in our "Intake" columns as they are never truly the property of Planned PETHood.
