

2026 1ST QUARTER IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS



PLANNED PETHOOD OF GEORGIA

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Q1 SUMMARY

Nearly **5,000 animals** were served by **Planned PETHood's programs** from January to March 2026 - including pets, community cats and shelter animals.

Planned PETHood was recognized with a **2025 Best Of Gwinnett Award** in the Pets and Animal Services category.

This lifesaving impact was made possible by our dedicated staff and volunteers, and the generous support of donors, sponsors, and community partners.

RESCUE & ADOPTION

81 cats and kittens were rescued from at risk situations including over-crowded shelters and dangerous outdoor conditions.

Planned PETHood provided medical care, spay and neuter surgeries, food and foster homes, then matched each feline with a loving adopter. This included 44 pet cats and 37 barn cats.

SPAY AND NEUTER

Completed **2,269 affordable spay and neuter surgeries** for pets, community cats through Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return (TNVR), and shelter animals, addressing the root cause of pet overpopulation.

This **nearly doubles our Q1 2025 surgery total** (1,244), driven by expanded capacity - including a team of four full-time veterinarians and the February launch of our **new FIDO mobile spay and neuter service**, bringing care directly to underserved communities.



AFFORDABLE WELLNESS

Provided **3,201 affordable wellness appointments** at our Duluth clinic, and reached an additional 463 pets through two free, offsite vaccine clinics in Jackson and White counties- expanding access to preventive care for families facing financial and logistical barriers.

Together, these efforts prevent unnecessary suffering, keep pets in their homes, and reduce intake at local shelters.
